Sidespeople at St Chads: We urgently need more volunteers to help set up and put away chairs after services at St Chad's. The aim is to have enough people, so that you are only on duty once every six weeks and working in pairs. In addition the role involves welcoming people, giving out the books, taking the offertory and letting Junior Church know that it's time to come back into the service. We will ensure that new volunteers are paired up with existing people so that you can have "on the job" training!
