#### All :Glory to you, O Lord

13Someone in the crowd said to Jesus, 'Teacher, tell my brother to divide the family inheritance with me.' 14But he said to him. 'Friend, who set me to be a judge or arbitrator over you?' 15And he said to the crowd, 'Take care! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; for one's life does not consist in the abundance of possessions.' 16Then he told them a parable: 'The land of a rich man produced abundantly. 17And he thought to himself, "What should I do, for I have no place to store my crops?" 18Then he said, "I will do this: I will pull down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. 19And I will say to my soul, 'Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry." 20But God said to him, "You fool!
