BANNS

If both of you live in St. Bartholomew's parish you will need to complete one banns form.

If one of you lives outside St. Bartholomew's parish you will also need to have your banns called in that parish and obtain a certificate to that effect.

The banns are called on 3 Sundays (usually consecutively) and are valid for 3 months.

It is advisable to hear your banns called at least once.

If you are getting married by Special Licence your Banns will not be called and you will not be charged.

FEES

An account will be sent to you prior to the wedding, which must be paid in full at least 1 month before the date of your marriage. Payment can be either by cash or cheque (made payable to "Thurstaston PCC") or BACS Transfer.

² The Verger will put out traffic cones to aid access to church for Bridal Cars, and to maintain safety of access for local residents who live in cottages behind church. The Verger will also clear up church following your wedding (eg collecting up excess service sheets) and locate any property that your guest might leave behind (last year everything from mobile phone's to children's toys). Flowers for your Wedding

You are welcome to place flowers in church for your wedding. Your florist would be required to contact Mrs Elaine Jones (648 1400) to arrange for access to the church. This will need to be arranged around any other commitments that the church has (eg funerals).

Alternatively, Mrs Elaine Jones (648 1400) who is a member of the church congregation is able to offer white flowers in the sanctuary and one arrangement in the main body of the church for £50.00.

In addition to that she is able to offer white flowers around the lychgate for a further cost of £75.00.

If available, Elaine will include flowers to match your colour scheme but this cannot be guaranteed.

Payment would be to the church flower fund account and Elaine would give you details of how and when to do this.
