Thank you for your continued gifts of time and materials to support our key workers. An amazing 158 kit bags went to Arrowe Park Hospital, some to The Royal and I think also Alderhey.

The need now is for Care/Nursing Homes , having spoken to 3 on the Wirral , the main need if for pairs of hearts Ψ as families and loved ones are struggling being separated for so long.

When last speaking to them the virus had not struck, so the kit bags are not a priority, but

good sense to have, so if you want to carry on making them please do, they will be glad of them. However if you can knit or sew pairs of hearts in any cheerful colour, that would be wonderful. I have attached a photo some hearts received so far. The finished hearts should be approximately 6.5cm high x 6.5cm wide.

There are approximately 140 staff and 150 residents in total, one home is only small so they have had delivered all their kit bag needs this week (14) and need 16 pairs of hearts of which I already have 14 pairs!

I had access to some wool at the time of writing, if you need any, and I still have some cord and material.
